What is Windows 10 End of Support?

Windows 10 ended support on October 14, 2025. Microsoft will no longer provide software updates, security fixes, or technical assistance to Windows 10 PCs. PCs running Windows 10 will continue to function.

While your Windows 10 PC will continue to function, it will no longer receive regular security updates, making the device more vulnerable and susceptible to viruses and malware. Windows 10 PCs may also experience slower performance and functionality across the device and applications.

What are the benefits of Windows 11?

Windows 11 Pro delivers advanced security and faster performance. It is business ready providing enterprise level management while helping employees become more productive with Microsoft 365 Copilot and modern features like snap layouts.

What are the main options for moving to Windows 11?

Microsoft knows many people rely on their Windows 10 PC every day. With Windows 10 support ending on October 14, 2025, our goal is to help ensure a smooth, secure, and seamless transition, providing the information and resources needed to choose the path that works best for the customer.

- Upgrade your Windows 10 PC to Windows 11. For PCs eligible to upgrade to Windows 11, Microsoft strongly encourages users to update, as it provides the highest level of security for a device. The upgrade is available at no additional cost.
- Explore Windows 11 and Copilot+ PCs. There are a broad portfolio of Copilot+ PCs and Windows 11 PCs available today, offering choice and value across a range of price points. Upgrade to a new Windows 11 or Copilot+ PC for faster performance, enhanced security, and longer battery life with the latest features and experiences to help with productivity and creativity.
- Enroll in the Extended Security Updates program. For Windows 10 customers that may require additional time before moving to a PC eligible for Windows 11, Microsoft is offering Extended Security Updates (ESU) for Windows 10 commercial and consumer customers. This provides continued protection through October 13, 2026. Commercial customers can purchase ESUs for up to three years.

Tell me more about ESU for commercial customers?

For organizations that need a little more time to transition for some of their Windows 10 PCs, they can subscribe to ESU for \$61 USD per device to receive monthly critical and important security updates for one year. The subscription can be renewed annually for up to three years, with the cost increasing each year. ESU is not intended to be a long-term solution rather a short-term solution to ensure Windows 10 PCs stay secure during the transition period. Some of my SMB customers have only a few PCs, can they use the Consumer version of ESU?

Customers that do not use an Entra ID, are not joined to an Active Directory domain, or not IT-managed (e.g. Mobile Device Management (MDM) solution), may be eligible for the consumer ESU program that offers updates until October 13, 2026, providing time to transition to Windows 11. <u>Windows 10 Extended Security Updates | Microsoft Windows</u>.

These customers are also eligible to enroll in the commercial ESU program if they need longer to transition to Windows 11. Commercial ESU program is available for up to three years and requires a one-year commitment. Since ESUs are cumulative, customers deciding to enroll in year two or three must retroactively purchase the previous years.

Microsoft recommends customers look across their current Windows PC portfolio and put together a plan to transition to Windows 11 Pro. This may include upgrading eligible PCs to Windows 11, purchasing new Windows 11 Pro PCs, and / or enrolling in ESU for those devices that need more time to transition.
